

# CANCER OUTREACH

Generous donations allow the Cancer Outreach Program to offer financial assistance, support and resources to cancer patients living or working in Mono County.

Since Mammoth Hospital does not offer primary oncology care, local residents travel out of the area to receive such care. Through donations, we can financially assist with gas, meals, and lodging needs.

## The goals of the Mammoth Hospital's Cancer Outreach Programs are:

- To provide financial assistance for travel-related expenses directly to cancer patients as presented to the committee through the funding application.
- To provide information, resources, and psycho/social support to cancer patients through Mammoth Hospital and the Cancer Outreach Program.
- To educate residents and visitors of the outreach programs and services available.

### Cancer Support Group

The participants of the cancer support group are an informal group, all facing cancer, who join together to provide mutual assistance in an understanding and confidential setting.

### Cancer Treatments

Mammoth Hospital's Chemotherapy Infusion Services provides chemotherapy and care to cancer patients in all stages of illness and health since 2001. In order for a cancer patient to receive chemotherapy here in Mammoth, they must have the support of their Oncologist. We provide I.V. chemotherapy infusions, coordination of care with the Oncologist, and any necessary supportive care. Some Oncologists are uncomfortable with a long distance relationship with their patients. If a patient is receiving chemotherapy in the Oncologist's office, we can still be used as a resource and part of their support system.

### Grief Support Group

We all, at one time or another in our lives, experience some degree of grief. Counseling and support services may be helpful to a person with regular grief reactions. Mammoth Hospital provides a Grief Support Group.
