

EMERGENCY TIP OF THE MONTH – January **Prepare Your Vehicle for Emergencies**

Be prepared for minor and more major emergencies while traveling. Be sure your vehicle is winterized before cold weather hits. Put your own supplies together or purchase a ready packed kit.

- Fire Extinguisher
- Crank Flashlight
- Flares & Safety Triangle
- Jumper cables
- Duct tape
- First Aid Kit
- Pens/pencils & paper/notebook
- Map of the area
- Paper towels
- Trash bags – large (could use as a poncho to stay dry)
- Emergency Phone number list
- Hand wipes
- Toilet Paper
- Water
- Snacks-**Don't leave in the car due to bears**



For Winter Prepare for All Your Travelers:

- Ice Scraper with Brush
- Extra Clothing – gloves, jackets, pants, boots, hats, neckgator/scarf, goggles, hand warmer packs
- Broom with a long handle
- Blanket
- Shovel
- Chains to fit your vehicle tires
- Sleeping bag(s)
